SUBJECT: (1) Periodicals and Indexes of the Computer Industry

(2) Recommendations for a minimal, basic subscription list for office libraries.

The Technical Information Service of Computer Usage Development Corporation functions as a clearinghouse and referral center for industrial, technical and professional information about the computing industry. The materials collected, disseminated and stored by TIS are selected to reflect CUC's current wide interests. TIS is not an archival depository. However, it has far-reaching contacts from whom information and materials not in TIS can be obtained quickly as needed.

Information is useful only when it is immediately available to the user as he needs it. Following this philosophy, the Technical Information Service attempts to strengthen office and personal libraries by supplying offices and analysts with pertinent materials, and alerting them to other items that are available and should be procured by them.

Periodicals are one source of information. We are enclosing (1) a list of magazines and indexes to the computer related literature currently received by TIS. The second list (sent only to managers) includes our recommendations for a basic, minimal group of publications which should be received in each office.

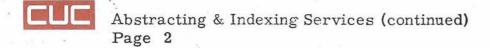
