ASHTON-TATE INTRODUCES dBASE III PLUS LAN PACK,  
A NETWORK-ONLY SOLUTION FOR dBASE III PLUS

LAS VEGAS, November 20, 1985 -- Ashton-Tate, developer and marketer of the industry-standard dBASE family of database products, today introduced dBASE III PLUS LAN Pack, which enables multiple users to share dBASE III PLUS files on a local area network (LAN).

dBASE III PLUS LAN Pack consists of three dBASE Access programs, which provide three additional users with economical, network-only access to dBASE III PLUS, the new database management system also introduced today by Ashton-Tate. Equipped with built-in multi-user capability, as well as stand-alone capability, dBASE III PLUS can network an unlimited number of users (within limits of the hardware). Combining one dBASE III PLUS with one LAN Pack provides a four-user network, the most common entry-level local area network configuration.

Each dBASE Access program in the LAN Pack connects to the dBASE Administrator resident on dBASE III PLUS. The dBASE Administrator provides true multi-user access to dBASE III PLUS files. It acts as a monitor, preventing simultaneous access to

the same record (record locking) or file (file locking), and limiting access to data to authorized users on the network.

"Sharing information and peripheral resources have always been attractive objectives because of the economic benefit," said Edward M. Esber Jr., president and chief executive officer of Ashton-Tate. "The dBASE III PLUS LAN Pack is an extremely cost-effective networking solution at a cost of less than \$425 per user.

"We are responding to our users by requiring only one copy of dBASE III PLUS to implement a multi-user capability," Esber said. "According to our research, 90 percent of computer users who are going to LANs are coming from stand-alone product use. dBASE III PLUS can be used as a powerful stand-alone product until the need to migrate to a LAN arises. It can then be linked on a network to other copies of dBASE III PLUS, or to dBASE Access programs from dBASE III PLUS LAN Pack."

dBASE III PLUS and dBASE III PLUS LAN Pack will run on any network that supports the PC-DOS Version 3.1 operating system, including the IBM PC Network, 3COM's 3Plus, or Novell's Advanced NetWare Version 1.01 or higher. Other LANs that use a PC-DOS 3.1 compatible operating system may also support dBASE III PLUS and dBASE III PLUS LAN Pack.

Available in January 1986 with a suggested retail price of \$995, dBASE III PLUS LAN Pack includes three dBASE Access key programs and three full sets of dBASE III PLUS documentation.
