**ASHTON-TATE ANNOUNCES FIRST AUTHORIZED TRAINING CENTER
IN U.S.S.R.**

Torrance, California, -- July 19, 1990 -- Ashton-Tate Corporation (NASDAQ: TATE) today announced an agreement with the Novosibirsk Institute of Electrical Engineering whereby the Institute will become the company's first authorized training center in the Soviet Union. Under the agreement the Institute will organize and conduct formal training courses for Ashton-Tate's dBASE database management systems, Framework integrated decision support programs and APPLAUSE II graphics software. The institute will also develop and produce training materials in Russian. Over 100 programming professionals are scheduled for training by December 1990.

"This announcement marks a significant first step in opening up the vast wealth of technical talent and expertise in Siberia to the West; while at the same time, formally training the Soviet technical community on leading Western software products," said Bruce Marquart, Ashton-Tate's manager for Eastern Europe. "We are pleased that Ashton-Tate was selected to be the first major software company in the world to establish regular commercial, educational and marketing programs in this market."
