During 1968, our company has experienced dramatic growth, both in revenue and in people. The prospects for 1969 are an acceleration of this dynamic growth pattern. In line with this expectation, certain alterations in the Corporate and Technical Division structures have taken place. Attached is a new organization chart for the Technical Division. You will notice several important changes.

The Program Library and Documentation Group no longer exists as a part of the Technical Division. Instead, a new group has been formed reporting to the Director of Marketing, entitled Marketing Information and Communications. The functional responsibilities of this organization are greatly modified and expanded as compared to the former Program Library and Documentation Group. More information regarding this organization will be forthcoming in the near future.

It is my pleasure to announce the formation of two new groups and several reassignments and promotions within the Technical Division. The two new groups are Software Quality Control and Applications Programming.

Applications Programming is not yet really under way but appointments to this group will be announced shortly and a complete description of functions and responsibilities will be published.

Tom Manuel, having done an outstanding job as Marketing/Tech Support Liaison is promoted to the position of Group Manager, Software Quality Control. Software Q.C. incorporates most of the functions formerly performed by Marketing/Tech Support Liaison and Computer Operations Liaison. A complete description of the functions and responsibilities of this group will be published later as will appointments to this group.

Paul Brickey, formerly responsible for Computer Operations Liaison, is promoted to Project Manager, Product Support, reporting to Jim Barker, Manager, Computing Systems and Devices Group. Tony Sica, who formerly reported to Paul Brickey in Computer Operations Liaison will continue to report to Paul Brickey but as a member of the Product Support team.

Howard Steadman has been promoted to Project Manager, Development Engineering, reporting to Jim Barker. This team was responsible for development of our new Tymshare Terminal Computer and we will be seeing more new and outstanding products from them.

Denny Moore has been appointed Project Manager, Systems Engineering, reporting to Jim Barker. He will be responsible for systems interfacing and incorporation of new products into the Tymshare timesharing system complex. Dennis Loudon, formerly of SWD Computer Operations, has been appointed a member of this team and will report to Denny Moore.

Gary Gorgen, formerly with the Program Library and Documentation Group doing applications programming, has transferred to the Operating Systems Programming Group and now reports to Norm Hardy. His field experience will be invaluable to this group.

New functional responsibilities have been assigned within the Subsystems Programming Group. Richard Moore is now responsible for all programming languages implemented under the Tymshare Conversational Compiler System and has been appointed Project Manager of that team. Walter Main has been promoted to Project Manager for CAL and BASIC Subsystems. Frank Bracher is Project Manager for Business Programming Languages with the charter to bring some into existence. Frank is deep in this task and we may expect outstanding results from his team, if not immediately, at least with great confidence.



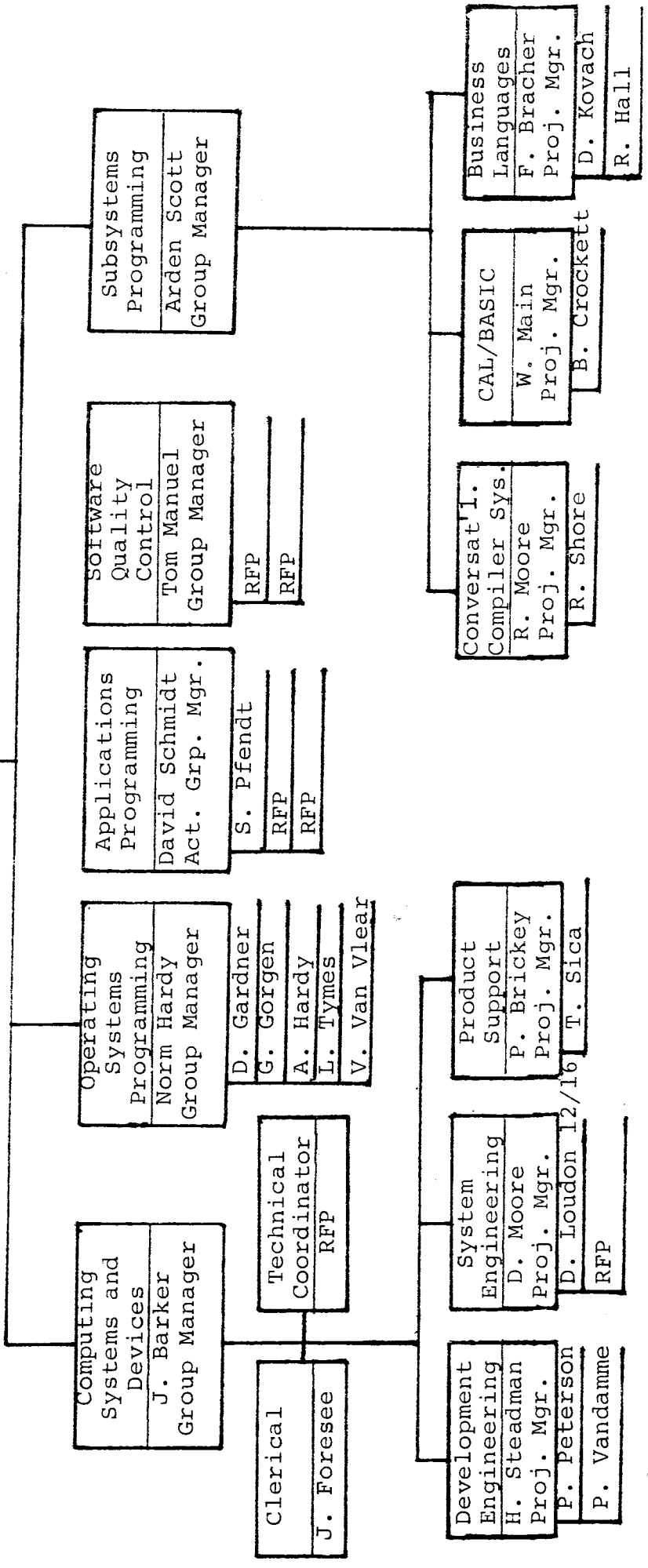
