promotional package in the fourth quarter, 1990.

Framework XE combines seven programs -- word processing, spreadsheet, data management, graphics, outlining, telecommunications and electronic mail -- into one "windows-like" environment that maximizes productivity and ease-of-use. The software also includes a "quick start menu" for first-time and occasional users, a built-in time manager and calculator, and extensive data sharing capabilities.

"Framework XE expands our decision support product line by offering users software at different levels and on different platforms," said Bill Lyons, Ashton-Tate president and chief (more)

operating officer. "And its ease-of-use, extensive functionality and low price make Framework XE a compelling product."

Added Richard Goodhue, Ashton-Tate's senior product manager for decision support products, "Framework XE is a perfect complement to Framework III, Ashton-Tate's integrated software that was first introduced in 1984. Framework III features the FRED programming language, LAN support, and extras like multiple columns and advanced outlining. There is complete file compatibility between the two products, and Framework XE users can migrate to Framework III and future Framework products as their needs grow."
