Upgrade to MultiMate Advantage II ships on schedule

4.0, the company's DOS-based word processor.

This new version includes integrated electronic mail, a grammar checker, transparent file conversion, a DOS shell feature to run other software and several features targeted to the legal market, including redlining. The product has a suggested retail price of \$565 and is available through all Ashton-Tate authorized resellers.

New Features and Benefits

With nearly 150 new and enhanced features, MultiMate version 4.0 users can now produce more informative and persuasive documents.

Moreover, both production word processing and new or casual users can learn and use MultiMate quickly and easily via extensive pull-down menus.

Major new features in the product include:

- -- Integrated electronic mail
 MultiMate has integrated Action Technology's Message
 Handling Service (MHS) to provide communication with standalone and network MHS users (such as Framework III from
 Ashton-Tate). In addition, gateways provide communication
 with those on IBM PROFS, DEC All-In-One, DISOSS and Wang
 Office, as well as public mail such as MCI Mail.
- Grammar checking
 Grammatik IV, completely integrated through MultiMate's pull-down menus, helps users improve the readability of their documents. The grammar checker highlights stylistic and grammatical errors, suggests corrections, estimates readability by grade level and generates summary statistical reports.
- -- Transparent document conversion
 Almost instantaneous text import from a long list of
 software -- including WordPerfect, Microsoft Word, WordStar,
 Lotus 1-2-3 and Framework -- eliminates lengthy conversions.
 The imported text is automatically converted and formatted,
 so users save time and keystrokes. Once work is completed,
 the new document can be saved in MultiMate version 4.0
 format or exported to any other supported format.
- -- "Run other software"

 MultiMate shrinks to 12.5K of RAM, then lets users directly access and run other software through MultiMate's pull-down menus, thereby saving time and keystrokes.

In addition, MultiMate version 4.0 includes larger document size (up to one and a half megabytes), macro editing, improved cursor movements and faster spell checking. To meet the needs of the legal market, MultiMate version 4.0 includes line numbering, redlining, tables of authorities and a legal dictionary.
