ASHTON-TATE DEMONSTRATES FRAMEWORK II TO USER GROUPS

CULVER CITY, Calif., Oct. 25, 1985 -- Ashton-Tate today announced that two principal software developers from its Forefront Development Center will demonstrate the new Framework II product to major user groups nationwide.

Robert Carr, director of the Forefront Development Center, and Greg Stikeleather, one of Ashton-Tate's senior software analysts, will lead the Framework II user group demonstrations.

Carr is the chief designer of Framework II and the recipient of a Technical Excellence Award from <u>PC Magazine</u> for his efforts in developing Framework. A pioneer in the field of integrated software, Carr was a programming consultant on the development of Context MBA, one of the first integrated packages introduced.

Stikeleather was involved in the development of the Lisa computer -- forerunner to the Macintosh -- at Apple Computer before joining Ashton-Tate's Forefront Development Center to work on the design and coordination of Framework II's user interface.

Built on the company's widely-acclaimed Framework integrated product, Framework II combines a faster, larger and more

powerful spreadsheet with an advanced word processor that includes an 80,000-word spelling checker and built-in mailmerge.

The two primary applications of word processing and spreadsheets are supported by fully-integrated telecommunications, database, outlining and graphics functions in addition to an expanded programming language. Framework II will be shipped at the end of October to computer retail stores nationwide.
