

Library Resources

The Library collection is concentrated in areas relating to the development, marketing, and production of computers that use UNIX operating systems:

- Standards, both U.S. (ANSI, IEEE, Mil Specs, ASHRAE and more) and international (VDE, BSI, ISO, CCITT, ECMA, and more)
- Articles from journals, conference proceedings, symposia
- Vendor information for materials used in our products
- Annual reports from our competitors

This information is available in a wide range of media:

- Books on business, computers, and engineering topics
- Journals from professional organizations, such as the ACM and IEEE, as well as magazines describing trends in the computer industry
- Microfilm covering vendor catalogs for major components used in our products
- Video tapes from the Tandem
 Television Network and from classes
 held both in Austin and Cupertino
- Audio cassettes with self-help information on management topics

The collection also includes general information, such as:

- Catalogs from local colleges
- Voting information
- Paperback book exchange
- IRS tax forms

Using the Library

The Library doors are never closed. Food and drink ARE permitted in the Library. And yes, you may talk in the library!

The Library operates on the honor system and asks that you follow a few conventions when you borrow its materials:

- Check out books for 4 weeks or more by completing the card in the back of the book and leaving it in the checkout box on Olga's desk.
- Check out back issues of magazines by filling out the appropriate information on the sign-out sheet. (Read current issues only in the Library.)
- Check out back issues of journals by filling out the appropriate information on the sign-out sheet. (Read current issues only in the Library.)
- Check out video tapes overnight during the week (over the weekend on Fridays) by completing the check-out card.

Ask Olga for help researching questions, for help locating resources, and for information or demonstrations of available services.

If you are new to Tandem, arrange a time for Olga to give you a library tour. When you are familiar with the library and its resources, you will get the most out of the materials and services available to you.

Library Services

The Library provides an online catalog that you can access from your own terminal for a listing of materials available in the Austin and Cupertino libraries:

Type LIBRARY at your TACL prompt.
 Online instructions will guide you.

The library subscribes to a wide range of journals and newspapers:

- · See Olga for a complete list of holdings.
- Ask Olga to add you to the Journal_Announce distribution list for notification several times a week of journal arrivals.

The Library gives you access to online bibliographic databases like Dialog Information Services, the UT card catalog, and Dow Jones News Retrieval:

- Ask Olga for a demonstration.
- To request a search, complete a green reference request form, which you will find on the librarian's desk.

The Library orders documents for you from:

- Other Tandem libraries
- Other special and university libraries
- Publishers
- Document delivery services

The Library notifies you monthly via PSMAIL of new resources in the library collection.


The Library has 5 UT library cards and a Book Stop discount card that you can borrow to check out or purchase materials for your own use.

F4 keyword - this is a <u>subject</u> search. Several words may be entered. eg. on-line transaction processing

F5 document no. - useful for research reports, eg. dec also useful for standards, eg. ansi

F6 call number - useful for special collections
eg. health or video or toast
