Stretch Systems - LASI System - work out variations

Phase I: Objectives,

- To enable present users to make firm plans for 1961
- To gain experience in marketing the Stretch system.
- To accomplish the above objectives so as to maximize our chances of success.

Action (^{regional} under control of applied science)
^{regional} mngs,

- General promotion by Region Reps.
- ^{Regional} DP Mktg prepares & presents a proposal involving contractual negotiations
- Full ~~all~~ sales coverage by Regional Reps. during negotiation.
- Regional & local reps. must install system.

Special Contract features a different contract,

- option to lease or purchase (in combination)
- option to revert to terms under commercial program if announced
- new extra shift policy
- deposit required on initiation of manufacture.







(later) Patents:

Constitution: Article I, Sect 8. --- exclusive rights --- guaranteed
laws ~1790. --- permits to exclude others --- can sue others.

Patent: period. 17 years. make, use, or sell.

Design patents - 3½ - 7 to 14 years.

"patent pending" - has been applied for.

Complaint: any new & usefull process, machine, composition of matter, manufacture
(chemical, etc)

new & improved of machines { e.g. sewing machine 4000
telephone

also plants --

also new design of manufacture.

Patent includes: drawings, Then description, Then claims "extent of
invention"

Cannot patent: - something which is in use - has been described in public
meeting

C: Consider Pi Redund
idea machine

Reduce: - build, or refine - file patent.

C-R

must show "diligence" between C & R - idea may be abandoned.
in between - law frames on this,

1st conceivon of idea gets patent

Patent disclosure form: - log book - preferably bound - dated & witnessed
properly in other area,
"read & understood"

Patent office: 600 Examiners - specialists in field
