Subject and/or Reference: STRETCH Mathematical  
Planning Group Meeting

In my recent telephone discussions with Dr. Roger Laurens of  
Los Alamos, we agreed that the date of the next joint Mathematical  
Planning Group meeting should be Monday and Tuesday, April 27-28,  
1959, at Foughkeppie. Unless plans are changed, we will plan to  
begin the meeting in the STRETCH Conference room at the South Road  
Laboratory at 9:00 a.m. April 27th.

The following items will be on the agenda:

- (1) A discussion of Dr. Laurens' letter of March 27. We should have  
a reply prepared in writing in advance, answering his questions and  
discussing the suggested machine changes seriously. I have already  
answered some of the simpler questions over the phone, but a written  
reply is necessary for the record. I shall be glad to work with whom-  
ever you designate in drafting the answer.
- (2) A discussion, (perhaps arranged separately from the main meeting) of  
the patent and legal implications of the speech which Dr. Laurens will  
give concerning STRETCH before the International Conference in Paris.
- (3) A review of the present schedule, particularly concerning the starting  
of the classes called for in the contract and the start of program testing  
by LASL.
- (4) Any other items of interest. (Note: This is probably the last chance  
we will have to meet with LASL before the Contract revision discussions  
start.)
