

QuickRef Card

This card has quick instructions for things you can do with your iPhone. You must register your iPhone before you can use the instructions on this card (see *Getting Started* for registration instructions). See the iPhone *Reference Handbook* for more information about using your iPhone.

How do I . . .

. . . connect to the Internet?



Press **Internet** to establish an Internet connection, then select anything on your screen to go there.

. . . disconnect from the Internet?



Press **Log Off** or lift the handset of the iPhone.

. . . find things on the Internet?



Press **Search**. Use the scroll keys to choose the method you want to use to conduct your search (called a "search engine"). Type a subject in the text box, then press Enter. Choose from the list of links displayed.

. . . remember a place on the Internet?



Press **Add Bkm** to create a "bookmark" for a Web site you want to return to later.

. . . go to popular Internet services?



Press **Listings**, then select the kind of services you're interested in (Yellow Pages or Movies, for example).

How do I . . .

... check for EMail?



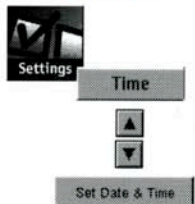
Press **EMail**, then press **Check**. A list of the EMail messages you've received appears. Touch the envelope symbol next to a message to read the message.

... send EMail?



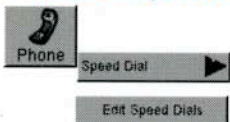
Press **EMail**, then press **Compose**. Enter the EMail address of the person to whom you are writing and type in your message in the appropriate field. Press Send to send the message.

... set the time?



Press **Settings**, then press **Time**. Select the time format you want, then use the keyboard to enter numbers. Press the **up arrow** or **down arrow** to select AM or PM. Press **Set Date & Time** to save your settings. (If you subscribe to *Caller ID* from your local telephone company, the time is set automatically for you when you receive your first phone call.)

... create a speed dial button?



Press **Phone**, then **Speed Dial**, and then **Edit Speed Dials**. Choose the Dialing tab, then select a speed dial button. Enter the phone number and name you want to assign to the button.


... create a directory of names, numbers, and EMail addresses?



Press **Directory**, then **Add**. Use the stylus to select fields, then type the name, phone number, and EMail address of your entry. Press Close to save.

... place a phone call from my directory?



Press **Directory**. Use the alphabetical tab keys and the scroll keys to locate the person you want to call. Press  to dial the primary number shown.
