The following technical reports in this box have accompanying descriptions:

#### Electronic spread sheet survey

"This document is intended to provide the reader with detailed descriptions of electronic spread sheet packages, available now and during FY 84 for internal use."

#### Installation of VDTs: an operators guide

"To make the best of the ergonomic tools and features built into its equipment, Digital Equipment Corporation suggests using the information in this brochure in incorporating computer terminals (VDT's) into a work area."

#### Tandem report

"This report summarizes the description of the Tandem 16 architecture and operating system features. The material was gathered from two Tandem manuals and two Tandem papers published at the January Hawaii Conference on System Science."

#### Engineering quality survey final report

"The purpose of the Engineering Quality Survey was to provide feedback from DEC engineering organizations with respect to employee attitudes in the area of product quality and development."

#### How is VMS used? Usage of VMS compared to other systems

"Command usage and program activation were recorded for a VMS system. These results were compared to results from UNIX and TOPS-10 systems."

#### Evaluation of the palm-rest for the VT100

"The report covers the research, testing and evaluation of the palmrest for the VT100."

#### Results of 1983 time usage survey

"A survey of U.S. sales people was carried out in the spring of 1983 to measure how sales people spend their time; this report summarizes the results of that study."

#### Preliminary design and implementation of local area disk server LAD

"Paper describes a preliminary design and implementation of LAD prototype which provides Local Area Disk services on Ethernet. The prototype demonstrates the feasibility of low-cost diskless workstations."

#### Trip report: Japan March 12 to March 23, 1984

"Report on trip to Japan in March 1984. Contents include sections on Japanese culture and how to live with jet-lag and other adjustments as well on comments on industrial visits."

Ethernet: a user's guide to successful implementation

"Intended to help IS/Communications Consultants evaluate, design, justify, and install a new type of DECnet network used in the local environment. Addresses the implementation of Ethernet from an internal user's perspective."

CIS jargon book: new terms for people

"Terms and acronyms accumulated by the author during her first few weeks at DEC in 1977."

Study of corporate cultures in the computer industry Japan

"Goal of report is to view the Japanese people and their industrial structure with implications for DEC."

RAINBOW III customer audit

"Third in a series of customer audits on the supported Rainbow customers. Data was analyzed in terms of influence on the overall satisfaction and recommendations by the customers. Summarizes findings from series of Rainbow customers audits to date."

ALL-IN-1 customer audit

"Paper is designed to answer several primary questions such as: what are typical ALL-IN-1 customers, their primary reasons for buying, the importance of customizability, their extent of satisfaction, etc."
