SOFTWARE PUBLISHER ASHTON-TATE NAMES RONALD POSNER TO BOARD

CULVER CITY, Calif. -- Leading microcomputer software publisher Ashton-Tate has appointed Ronald Posner to its board of directors, announced George Tate, company chairman.
