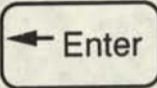

## Move Highlight

The four **ARROW KEYS** move  
the highlight around the screen  
to words in brackets called  
**OPTIONS**.

i.e.: <HELP>  
<FORUM>  
<EXIT>



## Go

Pressing this key activates  
the **OPTION** you highlighted.

You also need to press **ENTER**  
after typing an author name,  
password, or an index word.

## F1 Options

Press to see the **OPTIONS**  
available to you at any point.

i.e.: <ADD> a message  
<SPECIFY> an index word  
<REFINE> the message list

## F2 Backup

Press to back up  
**one-step-at-a-time**.

You may **BACKUP** all the way  
to the first screen.

Use it whenever you change  
your mind about requests or  
**OPTIONS**.

## F3 Help

Press to receive **HELP** any time  
you get stuck.

You will get specific instructions  
on what to do at that point.

# Reading Messages

The second screen offers you three options: <HELP>, <FORUM>, and <EXIT>. Pick <FORUM> to see a list of topics.

- 1 First you must pick a TOPIC.
- 2 Next, pick a FORUM from the list of related forums.
- 3 Then, pick an INDEX WORD from the index word list.

A list of MESSAGES will appear on screen.

Use the ARROW KEYS to move through the message list.

# Writing Messages

There are two ways to add messages of your own:

- 1 When you are in a FORUM, press F1 and pick <ADD>. You are on the way to adding a message to that FORUM.
- 2 Pick the <RESPOND> option in the top corner of the message you want to respond to. The message you write will then be attached to that message.

After you write your message, pick <FINISHED>.

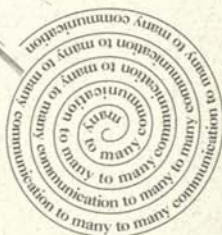
