




## ITH INFORMATION AT YOUR FINGERTIPS.

ing your goals. Want to know the books and reports available in your subject area? Need abstracts of articles or copies of the latest newsletters? The Corporate Information Center (CIC) is the place to go. Peruse these pages. They'll tell you everything you need to know about staying in the know. The collections are as diverse as the positions at Tandem!



### ND THERE ARE SEVERAL LOCATIONS TOO.

Besides CIC's central location, which holds our main collection, we have two other

branches. The Communications Library features materials in the fields of data communications and telecommunications. Support materials for the Transaction Systems Division and Transaction Networks Division can be found in the Technical Information Center. And a separate library, the Business Information Center, specializes in marketing information. The collections from all locations are com-

bined in one catalog conveniently located under LIBRARY on your terminal. Select an item and your terminal will tell you where the item is located.

Details follow!

We bave a large reference collection on business and technical subjects, including:

Regularly updated information on industries, companies, and products.

Materials from research firms such as Auerbach, Datapro, InfoCorp, IPC, Standard & Poor, and Gartner Group.

The IBM Service for Consultants, AI Research Highlights, and Japanese Technical Information Services (JTIS).

Approximately 350 journals in such areas as business. electronics, and computer programming are in our collection. We bave most of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE) and Association of Computer Macbinery (ACM) publications. Our collection of journals on Japan and Korea is growing. By request, you can receive a complete listing of journal boldings, updated quarterly.

Tandem publications, such as manuals, internal reports, and technical reports, are available. A complete set of current software and bardware manuals is kept as reference material for use in the CIC.

Research reports on technical subjects, reports from universities, and marketing reports from industry sources are available at the Technical Information Center.

Newsletters bave the most current information available in print on topics relevant to the computer industry. The CIC currently subscribes to approximately 130 of them, including FT Systems, Fiber Optics News, Outlook on IBM, SNA Perspective, Patty Seybold's Office Systems Report, Artificial Intelligence, World UNIX & C. and Korea High Tech Review. A complete listing of available newsletters can be sent to you on request.

On the more traditional side, you'll find the Wall Street Journal, Computerworld, the Asian Wall Street Journal, Electronic News, Barron's, PC Week, and many more. Our computer search service has access to newspaper databases, including the New York Times, Washington Post, Chicago Tribune, and a selection of smaller papers.




Our newest information delivery system is the CD-ROM. The Chicago Manual of Style Available on compact disc are the McGraw-Hill Concise Encyclopedia of Science and Technology, the American Heritage Dictionary, the Chicago Manual of Style, the World Almanac, the Zip Code Directory, a spelling verifier and cor rector, and much more



NEWSNET has access to the full text of many popular newsletters such as Seybold Report on Professional Computing, Software in Print, Telecommuting Report, and Video Disc and Optical Disc Update.





### HERE'S A TERMINAL IN YOUR LIBRARY.

The world of information is a big one and we're here to explore it with you. One of our

resources is our on-line access to research services, which enables us to scout in remote databases, bring back yesterday's *New York Times*, or map out uncharted territory in the form of bibliographies or abstracts of articles in your subject area. From this initial information, you can request full texts. Call us, give us a day or so to do our terminal traveling and we'll send you the results, either through your terminal or the mail. This service is available

to all employees regardless of location.


Once the catalog is available on your system, type LIBRARY at the prompt. An initial menu will appear on your screen that looks like the one below.




Let's assume you're looking for the Information Center's boldings for a particular author. Press F2 at the Initial Menu, and type the author's last name. If you are unsure of the spelling of the author's name, you may truncate, as in TELE. Now press F1; your terminal screen will show the Center's complete list of boldings on that author.

> Don't overlook the NOTES screen. Here you can browse through the table of contents or skim an abstract.

To access a particular title by that author, simply position the cursor at the appropriate line and press F2, as indicated. Information comparable to the traditional card you would find in a card catalog appears on the screen.






## HUMB THROUGH THE ON-LINE CATALOG.

A listing of the Tandem books and records is available through our on-line catalog. A staff

member can assist you in finding what you need. But did you know you can do it yourself, wherever you are in the Tandem world? At your terminal, by typing LIBRARY after the prompt, you can electronically browse to your heart's, or thumb's, content. These pages tell you how.

If the program isn't on your system, just notify your librarian, who will in turn let your systems manager know.

"It would be great to know what publications are coming out of the computer departments at MIT, Stanford and Berkeley. Do you have that kind of information? And speaking of publications, how about any of the research reports that come out of SRI? Do you have a list of their current research reports?"

We regularly receive lists of publications from a number of universities. The papers we receive are listed on our on-line bimonthly newsletter. A message to us stating which are of interest to you is all you need to do in order to receive a research report.

"It's really important for my group to bave the most current ANSI standard on Device Specific Command Set. Can you get it for me before next week?"

Yes, we can get ANSI standards as well as other standards from organizations such as ISO and CCITT in a very short time.

"I think this company I'm visiting next week is really owned by somebody else. Is there a way for you to find that out for me? And can you find out anything about who the company officers are? Maybe also where they might have branch offices?"

Business information databases are readily available and will provide you with complete company bistories, including business, financial and corporate affiliate information.

The videotape collection can be viewed in the video room located next to the Communications
Library: Seating accommodations up to eight people.
