You recall that at the last meeting of the Mathematical Planning Group June 30 - July 1, 1958, that some of the Los A lamos members, pmrticularly Ed Voorhees expressed intereat in reading the original timing efmulator memos which I reported upon at the meeting.

We certainly have no intention of keeping secrets from the people there, still the nature of the contents of these memos is such that they munt be treated as Compeny Confldential. For this reaton we are sending the coples to you instead of directiy to Los Alamos. You may let the members of the Mathematical Planning Group atudy the memos as much an they like but with the understanding that they are confidential and should eventually be returned to you.

Alee pelnt out that the memos were written at different times during a period in which the computer organization and the simulation code were both being changed, so that they must by their nature be somewhat obsolete.

When other reporta become available, I will make sure you are snciuded in the distribution.
